SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4040

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability 2 of implementing a prepaid college tuition program. 3 WHEREAS, during the 1980s the cost of college tuition rose faster than family income; 4 and 5 WHEREAS, people became concerned about the future ability of average American 6 families to afford college tuition for their children; and 7 WHEREAS, by implementing a prepaid college tuition program, people could pay 8 current tuition prices at participating institutions and be guaranteed that their children's tuition 9 would be covered, regardless of how high the costs rose in the future; and 10 WHEREAS, over 30 states responded to the concern about college affordability by 11 adopting some type of college savings program; 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE 13 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: 14 That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of implementing a 15 prepaid college tuition program; and 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 17 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 18 the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
