1 A concurrent resolution congratulating the Disher Rink curling team on winning the 1997 United
2 States men's curling national championship.

3 **WHEREAS**, the Disher Rink curling team is composed of Craig Disher, Hansboro; Kevin
4 Kakela, Rolla; Joel Jacobson, Langdon; and Paul Peterson, Langdon; and

5 **WHEREAS**, after placing second in 1994 and third in 1995 this team, representing
6 North Dakota and the Langdon Curling Club, came on strong at the end to win the 41st United
7 States men's national championship; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the Disher Rink team from Langdon will enjoy the title of Team USA for the
9 next year; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Team USA will now advance to the world curling championships to be held
11 in Berne, Switzerland, April 12-20, 1997; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in addition to the world championships in Berne, this team has earned a
13 berth into the United States Olympic trials to be held December 10-14, 1997, in Duluth,
14 Minnesota, to compete with the top six teams in the United States for the sole right to represent
15 the United States in the 1998 Winter Olympics in Nagano, Japan, where curling will be a full
16 medal sport for the first time;

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
18 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

19 That the Fifty-fifth Legislative Assembly extends to all members of the Disher Rink team
20 its heartiest congratulations for winning the 1997 United States men's curling national
21 championship; and

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
23 resolution to each member of the Disher Rink team.
