16	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 34-05-01.2 of the 1995 Supplement to the North	
17	Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:	
18	34-05-01.2. (For effective date, see Note) Department of labor to be administered	
19	by commissioner of labor. The department of labor must be administered by a commissioner	
20	of labor who must be elected for a four-year term on a no-party ballot in the year 1966 and	
21	every four years thereafter in the same manner as provided for no-party candidates pursuant to	
22	title 16.1. The term of the commissioner of labor commences on the same day following the	
23	commissioner's election as the terms for other elected state officials. The commissioner of	
24	labor shall possess the same qualifications for office as the commissioner of agriculture. The

- 1 annual salary of the commissioner of labor is fifty-two fifty-four thousand two nine hundred
- 2 ninety-seven forty-eight dollars through June 30, 1996 1998, and fifty-three fifty-six thousand
- 3 three <u>five</u> hundred forty-three <u>ninety-two</u> dollars thereafter.
- 4 (For effective date, see Note) Labor commissioner to administer department of
- 5 **labor.** Beginning January 1, 1999, the governor shall appoint a labor commissioner to
- 6 administer the department of labor. The labor commissioner shall serve at the pleasure of the
- 7 governor.
