- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the public service
- 2 commission; and to amend and reenact section 49-01-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to the salary of public service commissioners.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the		
6	funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in		
7	the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal		
8	funds, to the public service commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the public		
9	service commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999, as		
10	follows:

19	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 49-01-05 of the 1995 Supplement to the North		
20	Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:		
21	49-01-05. Salary of commissioners. The annual salary of a commissioner is fifty two		
22	fifty-five thousand seven four hundred eighty-seven sixty-four dollars through June 30, 1996		
23	1998, and fifty-three fifty-seven thousand eight one hundred forty-three twenty dollars
