The estimated 5 income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$20,444, or so much of the sum as 6 may be necessary, from the state fire and tornado fund for the purpose of defraying the 7 expenses of the anhydrous ammonia storage program. SECTION 3. ESTIMATED INCOME - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND 8 9 **PROTECTION FUND.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum 10 of \$1,491,902, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the environment and 11 rangeland protection fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the pesticide regulation, 12 pesticide disposal, pesticide registration, and noxious weeds programs, of which \$90,890 is for 13 the pesticide regulation program, \$552,133 is for the pesticide disposal program, \$66,000 is for 14 the pesticide registration program, and \$782,879 is for the noxious weeds program. 15 SECTION 4. TRANSFER. The office of management and budget shall transfer 16 \$100,000 from the environment and rangeland protection fund to the minor use pesticide fund. 17 for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999. 18 **SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the legislative assembly that the 19 board of animal health contract for veterinary services whenever appropriate and cost-effective 20 for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999. 21 SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 4-01-21 of the 1995 Supplement to the North 22 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 23 **4-01-21.** Salary of commissioner of agriculture.
