4	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
5	funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in
6	the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal
7	funds and other income, to the parks and recreation department for the purpose of defraying
8	the expenses of its various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending
9	June 30, 1999, as follows:
10	Administration \$1,637,039
11	Natural resources 6,785,188
12	Recreation
13	Total all funds \$9,889,324

SECTION 2. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION. Included in the program-based performance budget appropriation in section 1 of this Act is anticipated funding for the following: \$4,106,703 for salaries and wages; \$3,486,751 for operating expenses; \$284,370 for equipment; \$1,536,500 for capital improvements; and \$475,000 for grants. These amounts are provided for informational purposes only.

SECTION 3. SNOWMOBILE FUND. The amount of \$500,000, or so much of the amount as is necessary, included in the estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act, is from the snowmobile fund for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999.

- SECTION 4. TRAIL TAX TRANSFER FUND. The amount of \$15,000, or so much of the amount as is necessary, included in the estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act, is from the trail tax transfer fund for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999.
- 5 **SECTION 5.** ADDITIONAL INCOME. All income of the parks and recreation 6 department in excess of the estimated income appropriated in section 1 of this Act is hereby 7 appropriated to the parks and recreation department for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, 8 and ending June 30, 1999, and may be spent only upon authorization of the emergency 9 commission.
- **SECTION 6.** LINE ITEM TRANSFERS. Upon approval of the emergency commission, the parks and recreation department may transfer between various line items in section 1 of this Act appropriation authority of up to ten percent of a given line item to adjust for changing circumstances in meeting established performance measures. Any further transfers must be 14 approved by the budget section.
