1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the workers

2 compensation bureau and its divisions; to provide authorization to expend funds from the

3 workers' compensation contingency line item; and to amend and reenact section 65-06.1-04 of

4 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to civil air patrol workers' compensation

5 reimbursements.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 8 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in 9 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from the workers' 10 compensation fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the workers 11 compensation bureau for the purpose of defraying the expenses of its various divisions, for the 12 biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999, as follows: 13 Salaries and wages \$13,299,049 14 Operating expenses 5,190,609 15 Equipment 576,000 16 Managed care/TPA 858,386 17 Information reengineering 3,250,000

18 Contingency \$23,274,044 19 Total special funds appropriation

20 SECTION 2. WORKERS' COMPENSATION CONTINGENCY - EMERGENCY

21 **COMMISSION APPROVAL REQUIRED.** The sums appropriated in section 1 of this Act for the 22 workers' compensation contingency line item for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and 23 ending June 30, 1999, may be spent only upon authorization of the emergency commission.

SECTION 3. REPORT TO BUDGET SECTION. The workers compensation bureau is
 to report to the budget section on the expenditure of the \$350,000 provided for critical salary
 adjustments.

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 65-06.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

6 65-06.1-04. State reimbursement <u>Reimbursement</u> for liability in excess of

7 collected premiums. Whenever claim liability against the fund credited to the classification of

8 civil air patrol members exceeds the amount of premiums paid into such the fund, such the

9 excess liabilities shall be are a general obligation of the state of North Dakota adjutant general

10 of the North Dakota national guard as the North Dakota wing of the civil air patrol and shall

11 <u>must</u> be reimbursed to the bureau for credit to the workers' compensation fund through

12 legislative appropriation. <u>The adjutant general may use the funds available to it under the</u>

13 Federal Employment Compensation Act liability coverage to satisfy its obligation under this

14 section.
