1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the judicial branch;

2 to provide an exemption from the provisions of section 54-44.1-11 of the North Dakota Century

3 Code; and to amend and reenact sections 27-02-02 and 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century

4 Code, relating to salaries of supreme and district court judges.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 7 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in 8 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal 9 funds and other income, to the judicial branch for the purpose of defraying the expenses of its 10 various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999, as 11 follows: 12 Subdivision 1. 13 SUPREME COURT 14 Salaries and wages \$4,765,332 15 Operating expenses 1,525,506 16 Equipment 132,700 17 Judges retirement 342,416 18 **Dispute resolution options** 20,000 19 Total all funds \$6,785,954 20 Less estimated income 8,963 21 \$6,776,991 Total general fund appropriation

18 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is hereby appropriated any funds received by 19 the supreme court, district courts, and judicial conduct commission and disciplinary board, not 20 otherwise appropriated, pursuant to federal acts and private gifts, grants, and donations for the 21 purpose as designated in the federal acts or private gifts, grants, and donations for the period 22 beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999.

SECTION 3. TRANSFERS. The director of the office of management and budget and the state treasurer shall make such transfers of funds between line items of appropriation for the judicial branch of government as may be requested by the supreme court upon a finding by the court that the nature of the duties of the court and its staff requires the transfers to carry on properly the functions of the judicial branch of government.

SECTION 4. EXEMPTION. The supreme court equipment appropriation contained in section 1 of chapter 24 of the 1993 Session Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11, and \$75,565 of the unexpended funds from this appropriation are available for the purchase of a photocopier during the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999. SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 27-02-02 of the 1995 Supplement to the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

27-02-02. Salaries of judges of supreme court. The annual salary of each judge of
the supreme court is seventy-five eighty thousand nine five hundred thirty-six forty-six dollars
through June 30, 1996 1998, and seventy-seven eighty-three thousand four seven hundred
forty-eight sixty-eight dollars thereafter. The chief justice of the supreme court is entitled to
receive an additional two thousand one two hundred thirty-six seventy-one dollars per annum
through June 30, 1996 1998, and two thousand one three hundred eighty-four sixty-two dollars
per annum thereafter.

SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 27-05-03 of the 1995 Supplement to the North
Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

12 27-05-03. Salaries and expenses of district judges. The annual salary of each district judge is seventy seventy-four thousand sixty-eight three hundred thirty-one dollars 13 14 through June 30, 1996 1998, and seventy-one seventy-seven thousand four three hundred 15 seventy two four dollars thereafter. Each district judge is entitled to travel expenses including 16 mileage and subsistence while engaged in the discharge of official duties outside the county 17 city in which the judge's chambers are located. The salary and expenses are payable monthly 18 in the manner provided by law. A presiding judge of a judicial district is entitled to receive an 19 additional one thousand six seven hundred fifty six sixty dollars per annum, through June 30, 20 1996, and one thousand six eight hundred ninety-two thirty dollars thereafter.
