1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the judicial branch;

2 to provide an exemption from the provisions of section 54-44.1-11 of the North Dakota Century

3 Code; and to amend and reenact sections 27-02-02 and 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century

4 Code, relating to salaries of supreme and district court judges.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 7 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in 8 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal 9 funds and other income, to the judicial branch for the purpose of defraying the expenses of its 10 various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999, as 11 follows: 12 Subdivision 1. 13 SUPREME COURT 14 \$ 4,721,870 Salaries and wages 15 Operating expenses 1,511,006 16 Equipment 132,700 17 Judges retirement 337,405 18 **Dispute resolution options** 20,000 Total all funds \$6,722,981 19 20 Less estimated income 8,963

18 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is hereby appropriated any funds received by 19 the supreme court, district courts, and judicial conduct commission and disciplinary board, not 20 otherwise appropriated, pursuant to federal acts and private gifts, grants, and donations for the 21 purpose as designated in the federal acts or private gifts, grants, and donations for the period 22 beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999.

SECTION 3. TRANSFERS. The director of the office of management and budget and the state treasurer shall make such transfers of funds between line items of appropriation for the judicial branch of government as may be requested by the supreme court upon a finding by the court that the nature of the duties of the court and its staff requires the transfers to carry on properly the functions of the judicial branch of government.

SECTION 4. EXEMPTION. The supreme court equipment appropriation contained in section 1 of chapter 24 of the 1993 Session Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11, and \$75,565 of the unexpended funds from this appropriation are available for the purchase of a photocopier during the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999. 1 SECTION 5. AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT LEVELS. The maximum 2 authorized full-time equivalent levels for the 1997-99 biennium are 45.5 for the supreme court, 3 190.5 for the district courts, and 4.0 for the judicial conduct commission. 4 **SECTION 6. AMENDMENT.** Section 27-02-02 of the 1995 Supplement to the North 5 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 27-02-02. Salaries of judges of supreme court. The annual salary of each judge of 7 the supreme court is seventy-five seventy-nine thousand nine seven hundred thirty-six 8 seventy-one dollars through June 30, 1996 1998, and seventy-seven eighty-two thousand four 9 one hundred forty-eight sixty-four dollars thereafter. The chief justice of the supreme court is 10 entitled to receive an additional two thousand one two hundred thirty six fifty dollars per annum 11 through June 30, 1996 1998, and two thousand one three hundred eighty four eighteen dollars 12 per annum thereafter. 13 SECTION 7. AMENDMENT. Section 27-05-03 of the 1995 Supplement to the North 14 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 15 27-05-03. Salaries and expenses of district judges. The annual salary of each 16 district judge is seventy seventy-three thousand sixty eight six hundred sixteen dollars through 17 June 30, 1996 1998, and seventy-one seventy-five thousand four eight hundred seventy-two 18 twenty-four dollars thereafter. Each district judge is entitled to travel expenses including 19 mileage and subsistence while engaged in the discharge of official duties outside the county 20 city in which the judge's chambers are located. The salary and expenses are payable monthly 21 in the manner provided by law. A presiding judge of a judicial district is entitled to receive an 22 additional one thousand six seven hundred fifty-six forty-three dollars per annum, through 23 June 30, 1996 1998, and one thousand six seven hundred ninety-two ninety-five dollars 24 thereafter.
