TION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this	section, or so much of the

SECTION 2. ALCOHOL AND DRUG EDUCATION PROGRAM - EXPENDITURE -

LIMITATIONS. The moneys appropriated in the grants line item in section 1 of this Act for the Native American alcohol and drug abuse education program may not be spent for the services provided by the tribes to administer the program. The local grant recipient is required to provide match equal to the grant amount with funding or in-kind service.

SECTION 3. ESTIMATED INCOME. The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$200,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the children's services coordinating committee for the purpose of defraying the expenses related to the Native American youth alcohol and drug abuse education program.
