SENATE BILL NO. 2105 (Natural Resources Committee) (At the request of the State Water Commission)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 61-02-64.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the purpose of the contract fund.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 61-02-64.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

**61-02-64.1.** Contract fund - Purpose - Reimbursements to be deposited with the state treasurer. All contractual obligations of the commission, including obligations with respect to any works financed with bonds issued under this chapter, and excepting salaries and expenses of commission employees and the cost of any <u>office</u> supplies, materials, and equipment not related to works financed with bonds, <del>shall</del> <u>must</u> be paid from the contract fund. The moneys in the contract fund <del>shall</del> <u>must</u> be paid out or disbursed in <del>such</del> the manner <del>as may be</del> determined by the commission. Any moneys paid to the commission by any department, agency, or political subdivision of this or another state or of the United States or any person, corporation, or limited liability company to meet its part of the cost of a water project, shared with the commission on a matching basis, and as determined by a contract entered into with the commission, <del>shall</del> <u>must</u> be deposited with the state treasurer and are hereby appropriated out of the state treasury, and <del>shall</del> <u>must</u> be credited to the contract fund or held pursuant to the terms of the resolution or trust indenture of the commission adopted or entered into under this chapter.
