- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 6 of section 15-40.2-08 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the establishment of minimum standards and rules for determination
- 3 of educational costs for students by the superintendent of public instruction.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 6 of section 15-40.2-08 of the 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 6. An amount equal to the state average per student elementary or high school costs, depending on the educational level of the student, is payable to the admitting district or facility as part of the cost of educating the student for the school year.

 The department shall establish reasonable minimum standards and shall make such reasonable rules for the determination of educational costs as are necessary to carry out the purposes of this chapter. The payment may not exceed the actual per student cost incurred by the admitting district or facility. The remainder of the actual cost of educating the student not covered by other payments or credits must be paid by the state from funds appropriated for special education in the case of a student with disabilities, or from funds appropriated for foundation aid in all other cases within the limits of legislative appropriations.
