1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 43-09-02, 43-09-13.1, 43-09-14, 43-09-15.1,

2 and 43-09-18 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the state electrical board and

3 electricians.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-09-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 43-09-02. State electrical board - Members - Terms of office - Vacancies. The 8 state electrical board must consist consists of five six members appointed by the governor for a 9 term of five six years with their terms of office so arranged that one term and only one term 10 expires on June thirtieth of each year. One member of the board shall represent the public and 11 may not be directly associated with the electrical industry. The board must include a master 12 electrician who is a contractor two master electricians, one of whom must be a union contractor 13 and one of whom must be a nonunion contractor, a journeyman electrician, a consumer 14 member of a rural electric cooperative, and a person associated with an investor-owned utility. 15 A member of the board shall qualify gualifies by taking the oath of office required of civil officers 16 and shall hold his office until his a successor is appointed and qualified. The governor shall fill 17 any vacancy by appointment for the unexpired term of office. 18 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 43-09-13.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 19 20 43-09-13.1. Apprentice electrician registration. An apprentice electrician shall

register with the state electrical board within the first six months of employment and shall pay
an annual registration fee in an amount set by the board. An apprentice electrician may work
on installations only under the personal supervision of a licensed electrician as provided in

1 section 43-09-18. The master electrician employing the apprentice electrician is responsible for 2 all work performed by the apprentice in the course of the apprentice's employment. 3 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 43-09-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is 4 amended and reenacted as follows: 5 43-09-14. Master electrician and class B electrician - Undertaking - Fund. Before 6 entering into a contract agreement or undertaking with another for the installation of electrical 7 wiring or installation of electrical parts of other apparatus, a master electrician or a class B 8 electrician shall execute and deposit with the board an undertaking in the sum of three 9 thousand dollars for a master electrician or two thousand dollars for a class B electrician 10 conditioned for the faithful performance of all electrical work undertaken and the strict 11 compliance with all the provisions of this chapter and the requirements of the board. If the 12 master electrician maintains more than one business location in the state, the master electrician 13 shall deposit the required undertaking for each location. In addition, a deposit must be made 14 with the board in the amount of twenty-five dollars by a master electrician and in the amount of 15 fifteen dollars by a class B electrician, in lieu of a surety bond. The deposit so made must be 16 accumulated by the board in a special fund to be used for the completion of installations 17 abandoned by electricians referred to in this section, not to exceed the amount of three 18 thousand dollars for a master electrician and two thousand dollars for a class B electrician. The 19 board shall waive the deposit for a renewal of license by electricians who have made an initial 20 deposit under this section if at the beginning of the renewal year the fund exceeds thirty 21 thousand dollars. Funds in excess of thirty thousand dollars at the end of each year may be 22 committed and used at the direction of the board to inform and educate electricians concerning 23 the requirements of the electrical code. The board may prescribe forms for the undertaking and 24 make adopt rules it deems necessary to carry out the intent provisions of this section. 25 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 43-09-15.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 26 amended and reenacted as follows: 27 **43-09-15.1.** Continuing education. After March 31, 1990, each Each applicant for 28 renewal of an electrician's license pursuant to section 43-09-15 must have successfully 29 completed prior thereto at least four hours, and thereafter eight hours each biennium, of 30 continuing education relating to the standards set forth in section 43-09-21 or as otherwise 31 prescribed by the board. The board may not require more than sixteen hours of continuing

1 education in each biennium. The board shall conduct education sessions for licensees each 2 year at not less than six locations throughout the state. Attendance at such the sessions, or 3 attendance at other education sessions conducted by the school of science at Wahpeton and 4 certified and approved by the board as approved, fulfills the educational requirements of this 5 section. The board may charge a fee to licensees for attendance at the education sessions at 6 in an amount to be determined by the board, but not to exceed ten dollars per person for each 7 session. 8 SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 43-09-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is

9 amended and reenacted as follows:

10 **43-09-18. Apprentice to master electrician.** Any person may serve as an apprentice

11 under a licensed master electrician, but a master electrician may not allow an apprentice to

12 work on any installation without personal supervision of a licensed electrician and the master

13 <u>electrician is responsible for all electrical work performed by the apprentice in the course of the</u>

14 apprentice's employment.
