- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 25-01-03 and 25-02-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the qualifications and appointment of a medical director for the state
- 3 hospital.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 25-01-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 25-01-03. Supervising officer to appoint superintendent of institutions Salaries -
- 8 **Removal.** The supervising officer shall appoint a superintendent for each of the institutions
- 9 under its control, except for the state hospital, where the supervising officer shall appoint a
- 10 superintendent and a medical director in consultation with a state hospital governing body. The
- 11 tenure of office of each superintendent is two years from the date of the superintendent's
- 12 appointment, and the superintendent must possess qualifications required by this title. Any
- 13 superintendent may be removed by the supervising officer for misconduct, neglect of duty,
- 14 incompetency, or other proper cause showing the superintendent's inability or refusal properly
- 15 to perform the duties of office, but a removal at a time other than a termination of the
- 16 superintendent's two-year tenure may be had only after an opportunity is given to the person to
- 17 be heard before a board consisting of the governor, attorney general, and supervising officer of
- 18 the institution on preferred written charges. A removal when made, however, is final. The
- 19 supervising officer shall fix the compensation of each superintendent within the limits prescribed
- 20 in this title and within the appropriations made by the legislative assembly for compensation.
- 21 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 25-02-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 22 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 23 25-02-04. Superintendent to possess certain qualifications Medical director -
- 24 **Employees.** The superintendent of the state hospital must be a skilled health care

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1 administrator with professional training and experience relating to the management of facilities 2 for mentally ill and chemically dependent persons and relating to the needs of the mentally ill 3 and chemically dependent persons. A The medical director, who must be a licensed physician 4 and board-certified psychiatrist, shall appoint and employ recommend appointment of all 5 physicians and clinical staff, define their qualifications and duties, and be responsible for the 6 organization and delivery of medical and clinical services at the state hospital. The state 7 hospital governing body has final approval of all physician and clinical staff appointments to the 8 state hospital. The medical director must be appointed by the superintendent in consultation 9 with the supervising officer and with the approval of the governing body. If the superintendent 10 is not a licensed physician and board-certified psychiatrist, the medical director, or a qualified 11 designee of the medical director, shall act as the superintendent's designee in all matters in 12 which the superintendent's opinion on medical or clinical treatment is required by law. Every 13 physician on the professional staff must have a license issued by the state board of medical 14 examiners. The superintendent shall employ such other personnel as may be necessary and 15 shall define their qualifications and duties.
