1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 6-06 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to immunity of credit union volunteers.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 6-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 created and enacted as follows:

6 **Credit union volunteers - Immunity.** A person who serves as a volunteer, including a
7 director, credit committee member, or supervisory committee member, of a federal or state
8 chartered credit union is immune from civil liability for any act or omission resulting in damage
9 or injury if at the time of the act or omission all of the following are met:

- 10 1. The volunteer was acting in good faith and in the scope of that person's official
11 duties as a volunteer of the credit union.
- 12 2. The act or omission did not constitute willful misconduct or gross negligence on the
13 part of the volunteer.
- 14 3. The volunteer did not receive or expect to receive reimbursement for or payment of
15 expenses in excess of two thousand dollars per year for expenses actually incurred
16 as a result of providing services as a volunteer of the credit union and did not
17 receive or expect to receive compensation or anything in lieu of compensation as
18 payment for services provided as a volunteer of the credit union.

19 This section does not grant immunity to any person causing damage as the result of the
20 negligent operation of a motor vehicle.
