- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 14-02.1-02.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to information to be provided to pregnant women.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 14-02.1-02.1 of the 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

14-02.1-02.1. Printed information.

- I. The state department of health shall cause to be published publish in English, and in every other language that the department determines is the primary language of a significant number of state residents, within one hundred eighty days after July 1, 1991, the following easily comprehensible printed materials:
 - a. Geographically indexed materials designed to inform the woman of public and private agencies and services available to assist a woman through pregnancy, upon childbirth, and while the child is dependent, including adoption agencies. The materials must include a comprehensive list of the agencies available, a description of the services they the agencies offer and a description of the manner, including telephone numbers, in which they might the agencies may be contacted, or, at the option of the department, printed materials including a toll-free, twenty-four hour a day telephone number that may be called to obtain, orally, such a list and description of agencies in the locality of the caller and of the services they the agencies offer.
 - b. Materials designed to inform the woman of the probable anatomical and physiological characteristics of the unborn child fetus at two week four-week gestational increments from the time when a woman can be known to be pregnant to full term, including any relevant information on the possibility of

1		the unborn child's survival of the fetus and pictures representing the
2		development of a fetus at four-week gestational increments. The pictures
3		must contain the dimensions of the fetus and must be realistic and
4		appropriate for the stage of pregnancy depicted. The materials must be
5		objective, nonjudgmental, and designed to convey only accurate scientific
6		information about the unborn child fetus at the various gestational ages.
7	2.	The materials required under this section must be available at no cost from the
8		state department of health upon request and in appropriate number to any person
9		facility, or hospital.
