26	When a test of a weighing or measuring device is required in addition to the regularly				
27	scheduled annual test, a the commission shall charge of sixty cents per mile [1.61 kilometers]				
28	will be made unless a fee equal to the cost of operating the motor vehicle, including the testing

- 2 <u>be</u> in addition to the regular test fee <u>and calculated</u> to cover the costs of the additional travel.
- 3 Where a test has been requested and the person requesting it fails to appear or to have the
- 4 weighing or measuring device ready for testing at the arranged time, there is a charge of nine
- 5 dollars a quarter hour for the time between the arranged time and the time at which the test can
- 6 begin.
