HOUSE BILL NO. 1138 (Government and Veterans Affairs Committee) (At the request of the Public Employees Retirement System)

AN ACT to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-52 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to postretirement adjustments for supreme and district court judges under the public employees retirement system.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-52 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Judges postretirement adjustments. A supreme or district court judge who, on December 31, 1997, is receiving retirement benefits under subdivision b of subsection 4 of section 54-52-17 is entitled to receive an increase in benefits equal to two percent of the individual's present benefits with the increase payable beginning January 1, 1998. A supreme or district court judge who, on December 31, 1998, is receiving retirement benefits under subdivision b of subsection 4 of section 54-52-17 is entitled to receive an increase in benefits under subdivision b of subsection 4 of section 54-52-17 is entitled to receive an increase in benefits equal to two percent of the individual's present benefits with the increase payable beginning January 1, 1999.
