- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a teen pregnancy prevention media program by the department
- 2 of human services; and to amend and reenact section 12.1-20-05 of the North Dakota Century
- 3 Code, relating to the penalty for corruption of a minor.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 12.1-20-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

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12.1-20-05. Corruption or solicitation of minors.

- An adult who engages in a sexual act with another person or who causes another
 person to engage in a sexual act, is guilty of a class A misdemeanor if the other
 person is a minor, fifteen years of age or older, or is guilty of a class C felony if the
 adult is at least twenty-two years of age and the other person is a minor fifteen
 years of age or older.
- An adult who solicits a person under the age of fifteen years to engage in a sexual
 act or sexual contact is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

15 SECTION 2. <u>Teen pregnancy prevention media campaign.</u>

- 161.The department of human services shall create a joint program between public and17private organizations to design and establish a three-year media campaign for the18purpose of reducing adolescent pregnancy in this state. The media campaign19must include the following strategies:
- 20 <u>a.</u> <u>Delaying sexual intercourse among adolescents.</u>
- 21b.Educating males about sexual and parenting responsibilities including child22support.
- 23 c. Promoting communication skills to parents of adolescents to assist these
 24 parents in educating their children about sexual and parenting responsibilities.

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1		d. Promoting community involvement by adolescents for the purpose of building
2		self-esteem and individual skills.
3		e. Educating the community about the offenses of sexual contact with a minor.
4	<u>2.</u>	The department shall solicit bids for the design and operation of the media
5		campaign. The department shall adopt standard specifications for accepting bids.
6		The department may accept funds or property from any source for the purpose of
7		this section.
