- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 5-02-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the age of persons allowed to carry out packages in grocery stores that sell alcohol.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 5-02-06 of the 1995 Supplement to the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 5-02-06. Prohibitions as to persons under twenty-one years of age Penalty -
- 7 **Exceptions.** Except as permitted in this section, any licensee who dispenses alcoholic
- 8 beverages to a person under twenty-one years of age, or who permits such a person to remain
- 9 on the licensed premises while alcoholic beverages are being sold or displayed, is guilty of a
- 10 class A misdemeanor, subject to sections 5-01-08, 5-01-08.1, and 5-01-08.2. Any person
- 11 under twenty-one years of age may remain in a restaurant where alcoholic beverages are being
- 12 sold if the restaurant is separated from the room in which alcoholic beverages are opened or
- 13 mixed and gross sales of food are at least equal to gross sales of alcoholic beverages which
- are consumed in the dining area, if the person is employed by the restaurant as a food waiter,
- 15 food waitress, busboy, or busgirl under the direct supervision of a person twenty-one or more
- 16 years of age and is not engaged in the sale, dispensing, delivery, or consumption of alcoholic
- 17 beverages, or if the person is a law enforcement officer entering the premises in the
- 18 performance of official duty. Any person who is nineteen years of age or older but under
- 19 twenty-one years of age may be employed by the restaurant to serve and collect money for
- 20 alcoholic beverages, if the person is under the direct supervision of a person twenty-one or
- 21 more years of age, but may not be engaged in mixing, dispensing, or consuming alcoholic
- 22 beverages. Any establishment where alcoholic beverages are sold may employ persons from
- 23 eighteen to twenty-one years of age to work in the capacity of musicians under the direct
- 24 supervision of a person twenty-one or more years of age. A grocery store licensed for the sale

- 1 of alcoholic beverages under section 5-02-02.1 may employ any person who is eighteen years
- 2 of age or older but under twenty-one years of age to assist customers by carrying packages
- 3 containing alcohol, if the employee is under the direct supervision of a person twenty-one or
- 4 more years of age.
