STATEMENT OF PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT:

DEPARTMENT 770 - STATE WATER COMMISSION

HOUSE - This amendment continues the allocation of oil extraction tax revenues as follows:

- Twenty percent to the resources trust fund.

- Twenty percent as provided in Section 24 of Article X of the Constitution of North Dakota.
- Sixty percent to the state general fund.

This amendment also provides that during the 1997-99 biennium, \$2 million will be transferred from the state general fund to the resources trust fund.
