- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-03-07.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to goose hunting by nonresidents.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-03-07.1 of the 1995 Supplement to the
North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 20.1-03-07.1. Nonresident waterfowl hunting license required. Except as provided 7 in section 20.1-03-07.2, a nonresident may not hunt waterfowl unless that person first obtains a 8 nonresident waterfowl hunting license, in addition to a nonresident small game hunting license. 9 The nonresident waterfowl hunting license entitles the nonresident to hunt waterfowl in the 10 same manner as residents and to hunt dark or light geese for any period of fourteen 11 consecutive days or any two periods of seven consecutive days each and in specified waterfowl 12 goose hunting zones. A license authorizing two 7-day goose hunting periods may allow goose 13 hunting in a different zone during each period. The governor, in the governor's proclamation, 14 shall specify various waterfowl goose hunting zones for which nonresident waterfowl hunting 15 licenses will be available, and may specify the number of licenses which may be issued in each 16 zone and the manner in which they are to be issued. A nonresident is entitled to purchase only 17 one nonresident waterfowl hunting license per year.
