- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-35 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the inspection of schools by the state fire marshal; and to amend and
- 3 reenact section 18-01-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the duties of the state
- 4 fire marshal.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

<u>Inspection of schools - Submission of inspection report - Correction of</u> deficiencies.

- 1. The state fire marshal shall inspect each public and private elementary and secondary school in this state at least once every three years. The state fire marshal shall prepare an inspection report and categorize each noted deficiency. The state fire marshal shall provide copies of the report to the superintendent of the school district and the superintendent of public instruction.
- 2. a. If a noted deficiency is related to a school's design, it must be corrected whenever any construction, repair, improvement, renovation, or modernization of the school is undertaken, as provided in section 15-35-01.1.
 - b. If a noted deficiency is related to fire safety, the building principal shall remedy the deficiency within a time period acceptable to the state fire marshal or submit a plan of correction to the state fire marshal within a time period acceptable to the state fire marshal. The plan must be approved by the state fire marshal.
 - c. If a noted deficiency is an imminent fire hazard, the state fire marshal may request the building principal to take immediate remedial action or
