## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1053

- Page 1, line 7, replace "delivering appropriate" with "assisting small and rural districts with the delivery of"
- Page 1, line 9, after the period insert "To be eligible for funds under this section, a school district shall designate a coordinator to assist classroom teachers in providing educational services to gifted and talented students and, at the discretion of the school board, to provide educational services to gifted and talented students. The coordinator must be credentialed in gifted education or have a minimum of five years classroom teaching experience and special talents and abilities which, in the opinion of the school board, may be beneficial to other classroom teachers and gifted students. The coordinator must have an elementary, middle school, or high school credential; but for purposes of providing educational services to gifted students, the coordinator may, notwithstanding any other statutory or regulatory provisions, provide services to students in kindergarten through grade twelve, as determined necessary by the school board."
