## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivision b of subsection 1 of section 12.1-20-03 of the
  1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - b. He <u>That person</u> or someone with his <u>that person's</u> knowledge has substantially impaired the victim's power to appraise or control his or her <u>the victim's</u> conduct by administering or employing without his or her <u>the victim's</u> knowledge intoxicants, a controlled substance as defined in chapter 19-03.1, or other means with intent to prevent resistance;
  - **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision c of subsection 1 of section 12.1-20-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
    - c. He <u>That person</u> or someone with <u>his that person's knowledge has</u> substantially impaired the <u>other person's victim's</u> power to appraise or control <u>his or her the victim's</u> conduct, by administering or employing without the <u>other's victim's knowledge intoxicants, a controlled substance as defined in chapter 19-03.1, or other means for the purpose of preventing resistance;</u>
- SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 6 of section 19-03.1-05 of the 1995
  Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
