- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for the creation of a school district emergency repair and
- 2 maintenance revolving loan fund; and to provide an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. School district emergency repair and maintenance revolving loan

5 fund - Creation.

- 1. The Bank of North Dakota shall maintain a revolving loan fund for the purpose of
 loaning funds to school districts needing assistance with the costs of emergency
 maintenance and repair efforts. All moneys transferred into the fund, interest upon
 moneys in the fund, and payments to the fund of principal and interest on loans
 made from the fund are hereby appropriated to the fund on a revolving basis for
 the purpose of providing loans in accordance with this section.
- The Bank of North Dakota shall administer and supervise the revolving loan fund
 and loans made from the fund. The Bank may deduct a service fee for
 administering the fund from interest payments received on loans and may charge
 loan recipients a fee for managing and servicing loans.
- A school district seeking a loan from the fund shall apply to the Bank of North
 Dakota for a loan and, upon approval, the Bank shall make a loan from the fund in
 accordance with the provisions of this section.
- A loan made from the fund may not exceed the sum of five hundred thousand
 dollars per school district.
- A loan made from the fund must bear interest at a rate of five percent per year.
 The maximum term of a loan made from the fund is twenty-five years.
- 23 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in 24 the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$10,000,000, or

- 1 so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the Bank of North Dakota for deposit in the school
- 2 district emergency maintenance and repair revolving loan fund for the purpose of providing
- 3 loans to school districts needing assistance with the costs of emergency repair and
- 4 maintenance, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999.
