1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-03-07.1 of the North Dakota Century

2 Code, relating to waterfowl hunting by nonresidents born in North Dakota.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-03-07.1 of the 1995 Supplement to the
North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 20.1-03-07.1. Nonresident waterfowl hunting license required. Except as provided 7 in section 20.1-03-07.2, a nonresident may not hunt waterfowl unless that person first obtains a 8 nonresident waterfowl hunting license, in addition to a nonresident small game hunting license. 9 The nonresident waterfowl hunting license entitles the a nonresident to hunt waterfowl for any 10 period of fourteen consecutive days or, any two periods of seven consecutive days each and, 11 or if the nonresident was born in this state, any four 4-day weekends in specified waterfowl 12 hunting zones. A license authorizing two 7-day hunting periods or any four 4-day weekend 13 periods may allow hunting in a different zone during each period. A nonresident may prove 14 birth in this state by providing at the time the license is purchased a valid birth certificate 15 showing that that person was born in this state. The governor, in the governor's proclamation, 16 shall specify various waterfowl hunting zones for which nonresident waterfowl hunting licenses 17 will be available, and may specify the number of licenses which may be issued in each zone 18 and the manner in which they are to be issued. A nonresident is entitled to purchase only one nonresident waterfowl hunting license per year. 19
