- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 26.1-41 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to termination of basic no-fault benefits by basic no-fault insurers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 26.1-41 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 **Termination of basic no-fault benefits Treble damages.** A basic no-fault insurer
- 7 that has accepted a claim for basic no-fault benefits cannot terminate any basic no-fault
- 8 benefits until it has notified the claimant in writing at least thirty days in advance of its intent to
- 9 terminate basic no-fault benefits and of the reasons why the benefits are being terminated. A
- 10 basic no-fault insurer cannot terminate basic no-fault benefits retroactively. A claimant is
- 11 entitled to treble damages if a basic no-fault insurer failed to give notice as required or
- 12 terminated basic no-fault benefits retroactively.
