- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-11.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the public access to information regarding providers of early
- 3 childhood services; to provide for application; and to provide an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 50-11.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 created and enacted as follows:

7 Access to provider information - Exceptions.

- 8 1. The county agency of each county shall maintain the following information on each
- 9 provider of early childhood services licensed by the county under this chapter:
- 10 a. Name, address, and telephone number;
- 11 b. Name and relationship of other family members;
- 12 c. Type of dwelling;
- 13 d. Licensed capacity;
- 14 e. Class of license;
- 15 f. Previous license history;
- 16 g. Years of experience as licensed provider;
- 17 h. Variances granted;
- i. Carecheck registry placement, if any, under section 50-11.1-06.2;
- 19 j. Existence, substance, and status of any complaint;
- 20 k. Findings of any investigation of a complaint;
- 21 I. The record of any informal resolution of a licensing violation;
- 22 m. Any correction order, denial, revocation, suspension, or injunction issued as a 23 result of a complaint; and

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1		n. Orders of hearing, findings of fact, conclusions of law, and specifications of
2		the final disciplinary action contained in the record of disciplinary action.
3	2.	The following information on providers and other individuals is confidential:
4		a. Personal financial data on a provider and any family member who provides
5		services under the provider's license;
6		b. Details regarding any child abuse and neglect assessment; and
7		c. The identity of persons who have made reports concerning providers which
8		appear in investigative data.
9	3.	All records of a county agency regarding a provider, except information made
10		confidential under subsection 2 or other law, must be maintained in a separate file
11		and must be disclosed immediately upon request.
12	SE	CTION 2. APPLICATION. This Act applies only to the records of a provider who
13	applies for	licensure or renewal of licensure after the effective date of this Act.
14	SE	CTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act becomes effective on January 1, 1998.
