HOUSE BILL NO. 1396 (Representative Carlson)

AN ACT to create and enact a new subsection to section 20.1-03-11 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the hunting of mule deer by nonresidents.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 20.1-03-11 of the 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Fifteen percent of the total mule deer licenses and permits to hunt mule deer made available in the immediately preceding year for the regular gun season must be made available to nonresidents to hunt any deer with bow and arrow. Speaker of the House
