- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-12 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to enforcement of size and weight restrictions on motor vehicles.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 39-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- Enforcement by highway patrol. To determine compliance with this chapter by
 out-of-state vehicles, a member of the highway patrol, upon presenting appropriate credentials,
 and a written notice to the owner, operator, or agent in charge, may enter for inspection, during
 normal business hours, any factory, warehouse, or establishment within this state which loads
 or unloads trucks or truck tractor and trailer combinations. The inspection is limited to records
 that may provide evidence to determine if a person was or is operating a vehicle in violation of
 this chapter. This section does not apply to North Dakota resident farmers, ranchers,
- 13 manufacturers, or haulers of petroleum.
