- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 34-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the state minimum wage rate.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 34-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Relation of state minimum wage rate to consumer price index.

- 1. Notwithstanding section 34-06-03, the state minimum wage rate set by the commissioner as of October 1, 1996, must remain in effect until September 1, 1997, at which time the state minimum wage rate is five dollars and fifteen cents per hour. By May 1, 1998, and every twenty-four months thereafter, the commissioner shall review the state minimum wage rate to determine whether the rate reflects inflationary changes based upon the most recent annual average of the consumer price index for all urban consumers, United States city average.
- If the review indicates the minimum wage rate is not at least equal to the
 inflationary adjusted rate, the provisions of this chapter pertaining to the procedure
 to set the minimum wage rate do not apply and the commissioner shall adopt an
 order setting the state minimum wage at the inflationary adjusted rate.
