- A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-06-13 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to motor vehicle operator's license examinations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06-13 of the 1995 Supplement to the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **39-06-13. Examination of applicants.** The commissioner <u>director</u> shall examine
- 7 every applicant for an operator's license, except as otherwise provided in this chapter. The
- 8 examination must include a test of the applicant's eyesight, ability to read and understand
- 9 highway signs regulating, warning, and directing traffic, and knowledge of the traffic laws of this
- 10 state. During testing, any written portion of the examination, except writing on illustrations of
- 11 signs, must be made available to an applicant in any widely practiced language that is the
- 12 applicant's own language or through an interpreter approved by the director and paid for by the
- 13 applicant. An actual demonstration of ability to exercise ordinary and reasonable control in the
- 14 operation of a motor vehicle is also required, but may be waived for an applicant who has
- 15 successfully passed such a an actual ability test in this or another state. Operators'
- 16 examinations must be given at locations designated by the commissioner director. The
- 17 commissioner director may require such any other physical or mental examination as may be
- 18 deemed advisable.
