4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-10-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

16.1-10-04. Publication of false information in political advertisements - Penalty Civil penalty. No

- A person, political party, or political committee may not knowingly sponsor any or publish a political advertisement or news release that contains any an assertion, representation, or statement of fact, including information concerning a candidate's prior public record, which the sponsor or publisher knows to be untrue, deceptive, or misleading, whether on behalf of or in opposition to any a candidate for public office, initiated measure, referred measure, constitutional amendment, or any other issue, question, or proposal on an election ballot, and whether such the publication is by radio, television, newspaper, pamphlet, folder, display cards, signs, posters or billboard advertisements, or by any other public means. Any With respect to publication of untrue, deceptive, or misleading statements by communications media, this section applies only to advertising.
- 20 2. For the purposes of this section:
 - <u>a.</u> <u>"Advertising" means the commercial use of communications media.</u>
 - b. "Communications media" includes radio, television, newspapers, periodicals, and commercial billboards.

A person who, political party, or political committee that violates the provisions of
this section is guilty of a class A misdemeanor subject to a civil penalty of up to two
thousand five hundred dollars for each publication.
