- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 26.1-36 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to coverage for off-label uses of drugs.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 26.1-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 created and enacted as follows:

6	Cov	verage for off-label uses of drugs.		
7	1.	In this section:		
8		a.	"Coverage of a drug" includes medically necessary services associated with	
9			the administration of the drug.	
10		b.	"Medical literature" means scientific studies published in a peer review	
11			national medical journal.	
12		C.	"Off-label use of drugs" means prescribing drugs for treatments other than	
13			those stated in the labeling approved by the federal food and drug	
14			administration.	
15		d.	"Standard reference compendia" means the United States pharmacopeia	
16			drug information or American hospital formulary service drug information.	
17	2.	An i	nsurance company, nonprofit health service corporation, or health	
18		mair	ntenance organization that provides coverage for drugs may not issue, deliver,	
19		exec	cute, or renew any health insurance policy or health service contract on an	
20		indiv	vidual, group, blanket, franchise, or association basis which excludes coverage	
21		of a	drug for a particular indication on the grounds the drug has not been approved	
22		by tł	ne federal food and drug administration for that indication if the drug is	
23		reco	gnized for treatment of the indication in one of the standard reference	
24		com	pendia or medical literature.	

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1	3.	The commissioner of insurance may direct an insurer or contractor regulated by
2		this section to make payments as required by this section.
3	4.	The state health officer may appoint a panel of up to eight qualified medical
4		experts to review off-label uses of drugs not included in the standard reference
5		compendia or medical literature. This panel shall advise the commissioner of
6		insurance whether a particular off-label use is medically appropriate and shall
7		make recommendations regarding payment of off-label use.
8	5.	This section does not alter existing law regarding provisions limiting the coverage
9		of drugs that have not been approved by the federal food and drug administration;
10		does not require coverage for any drug when the federal food and drug
11		administration has determined its use to be contraindicated; and does not require
12		coverage for experimental drugs not otherwise approved for any indication by the
13		federal food and drug administration.
