1 A BILL for an Act to define the duties of the K-12 excellence task force; and to provide an

2 appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. Educational excellence task force - Members - Duties. The governor 5 shall appoint a K-12 excellence task force of nine members, eight of whom are to consist of 6 representation from the department of public instruction, the legislative assembly, school 7 administrators, school boards, teachers, business and industry, higher education, and parents. 8 The governor shall appoint the lieutenant governor as the ninth member, who shall serve as 9 chairman. The task force shall: 10 Develop and implement a plan to identify and evaluate core subject content 1. 11 standards suitable for adoption by the 1999 legislative assembly as curriculum 12 reference standards for public school districts; 13 2. Recommend technology resources to support standards-referenced curriculum in 14 public schools; and 15 3. Report its findings and recommendations regarding standards adoption and 16 technology funding to the legislative council on or before December 1, 1998. 17 SECTION 2. Meetings - Compensation and reimbursement of task force 18 **members.** The chairman shall set the time and place of all task force meetings. Each member 19 of the task force is entitled to receive the same per diem compensation as provided for 20 members of the legislative council under section 54-35-10, and reimbursement of expenses as 21 provided by law for state officers, while attending meetings or performing duties directed by the 22 council, except that no compensation under this section may be paid to any member who 23 receives compensation or salary as a regular state employee or official.

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SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in
the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,300,000, or so
much of the sum as may be necessary, to the superintendent of public instruction for the Myrdal
fund for excellence grants line item for the purpose of providing funds for expenditures incurred
by the K-12 excellence task force.
