- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 62.1-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to reciprocity for concealed weapons licenses.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 62.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
created and enacted as follows:

6 **Reciprocity.**

- A person who has a valid license issued by another state to carry a concealed
 firearm or dangerous weapon in that state and whose state grants to residents of
 this state the right to carry a concealed firearm or dangerous weapon without
 requiring a separate license to carry a concealed firearm or dangerous weapon
 issued by that state may carry, subject to the provisions of this state's law, a
 concealed firearm or dangerous weapon in this state, and the other state's license
 is valid in this state.
- 14 2. A person who holds a valid license issued by another state whose home state 15 permits a resident of this state to obtain a license to carry a concealed firearm or 16 dangerous weapon in that same state may apply directly to the bureau of criminal 17 investigation for a license to carry a concealed firearm or dangerous weapon in this 18 state. The bureau of criminal investigation shall issue a license to carry a 19 concealed firearm or dangerous weapon after verifying that the person applying 20 has a valid license to carry a concealed firearm or dangerous weapon issued by 21 that person's home state. If the other state requires testing, the bureau must test 22 under this state's laws accordingly.
