1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-20.2-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to the membership of area vocational and technology center boards.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15-20.2-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **15-20.2-04. Center boards - Appointment of members - Terms - Compensation -**
7 **Vacancies.** An area vocational and technology center must be operated by a center board of
8 not less than five members nor more than a total of one member for each participating district;
9 provided, however, that each participating school district with three hundred or more high
10 school students must be allowed one member for each three hundred high school students or
11 fraction thereof with a limitation of not more than three members from any one school district.
12 Center board members must be members or designees of the school boards. The terms of
13 office of the members of center boards must be for at least one year and terminate upon the
14 expiration of their terms on their respective school boards. Members are eligible for
15 reappointment to center boards. Center board members shall receive the same compensation
16 and expenses for attending center board meetings or for otherwise engaging in official business
17 for the center as provided in section 15-29-05 for members of school boards. Compensation
18 and expenses of center board members must be paid out of center funds.

19 Vacancies on a center board must be filled by the school board whose representation
20 was lost when the vacancy occurred.
