- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 53-06.1-03.1 and 53-06.1-03.3 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the site rental for certain games of chance.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 53-06.1-03.1 of the 1995 Supplement to the

 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - **53-06.1-03.1. Bingo sites Limit on rent.** For the privilege of conducting games at a site where bingo is conducted:
 - Except under subsection 3 4, if bingo is the primary game, the monthly rent must be reasonable.
 - 2. If bingo is not the primary game, but is conducted in conjunction with twenty-one, and paddlewheels, or pull tabs, no additional rent is allowed.
 - 3. If bingo is not the primary game, but is conducted in conjunction with paddlewheels or pull tabs, but not twenty-one, the monthly rent is an amount to be negotiated between the site and the organization which may not be less than ten percent nor more than seventeen percent of the monthly adjusted gross proceeds of the games of chance conducted by the organization at that site.
 - 4. If bingo is conducted involving only a bingo card dispensing device and no other game is conducted, the monthly rent may not exceed two hundred twenty-five dollars is an amount to be negotiated between the site and the organization which may not be less than ten percent nor more than seventeen percent of the monthly adjusted gross proceeds of the games of chance conducted by the organization at that site.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 53-06.1-03.3 of the 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- **53-06.1-03.3. Pull tab sites Limit on rent.** For the privilege of conducting games of chance at a site other than a site where bingo is the primary game:
 - If twenty-one is conducted on a site, in addition to the rent allowable for twenty-one, the monthly rent may not exceed one hundred twenty-five dollars.
 - 2. If twenty-one is not conducted on a site, the monthly rent may not exceed two hundred twenty five dollars is an amount to be negotiated between the site and the organization which may not be less than ten percent nor more than seventeen percent of the monthly adjusted gross proceeds of the games of chance conducted by the organization at that site.
