ENGROSSED SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4020

1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study and develop a long-term plan
2	for the investigatory and penological support mechanisms of the criminal justice system.
3	WHEREAS, cooperation is needed among fire arson investigators, sheriffs, police
4	officers, the state highway patrol, state's attorneys, the bureau of criminal investigation, the
5	state fire marshal, the department of corrections and rehabilitation, the state crime laboratory,
6	the state forensic examiner, and the state toxicologist for adequate investigation of crimes,
7	proper evidence handling, and efficient case tracking and management; and
8	WHEREAS, new technology provides more evidence, requires new equipment, and
9	necessitates skilled personnel to operate the equipment; and
10	WHEREAS, the state forensic examiner needs to be supported by a coroner system
11	that is effective, coordinated, and fiscally sound to adequately investigate deaths; and
12	WHEREAS, sheriffs and the department of corrections and rehabilitation need to
13	develop a long-range plan for the management of inmates;
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA,
15	THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
16	That the Legislative Council study and develop a long-term plan for the investigatory
17	and penological support mechanisms of the criminal justice system; and
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
19	recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
20	the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
