- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the impact of divorce on 2 children and issues of equity and fairness as they relate to custody determinations, visitation 3 orders, and child support obligations. 4 WHEREAS, 65 percent of the 1.2 million divorces in 1995 in the United States involved 5 couples with minor children; and 6 WHEREAS, children of divorced parents are two to three times more likely to drop out 7 of school, to have out-of-wedlock births, and to get divorced themselves than children from 8 intact families; and 9 WHEREAS, a child has a right to be supported emotionally, physically, and financially 10 by both parents regardless of the parents' marital status; and 11 WHEREAS, frequent and continuing access by a child to both parents after the divorce 12 should be encouraged; and 13 WHEREAS, concerns have been expressed that there are inequities in the enforcement 14 of visitation orders for noncustodial parents and in the child support guidelines as they relate to 15 parents who are obligors; 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 17 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 18 That the Legislative Council study the impact of divorce on children and issues of equity
 - **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
