HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3048

1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study fee hunting and the
2	qualifications for guides and outfitters.
3	WHEREAS, hunting opportunities are an economic and recreational benefit to the
4	people of this state and other states; and
5	WHEREAS, a good working relationship based on a common understanding of the
6	rights of both the hunter and private landowner is vital to the future of hunting in this state; and
7	WHEREAS, fee hunting provides much needed revenue to the farmers and ranchers of
8	this state but may also limit access to their land by resident hunters; and
9	WHEREAS, the Fifty-fourth Legislative Assembly considered proposed legislation that
10	would have required persons charging a fee to hunt, shoot, fish, or trap on their land to
11	purchase a license and to possess liability insurance; and
12	WHEREAS, the Fifty-fourth Legislative Assembly considered proposed legislation that
13	would have required guides and outfitters to possess liability insurance against loss or expense
14	due to accident or injury resulting from hunting, shooting, fishing, or trapping wildlife;
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
16	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
17	That the Legislative Council study fee hunting and the qualifications for guides and
18	outfitters; and
19	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
20	recommendations, together with any legislation necessary to implement the recommendations,
21	to the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
