A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the Indian affairs
 commission.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 5 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in 6 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal 7 funds and other income, to the Indian affairs commission for the purpose of defraying the 8 expenses of the Indian affairs commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending 9 June 30, 1999, as follows: 10 Salaries and wages \$230,410 11 **Operating expenses** 34,963 12 Grants 145,500 13 Total all funds \$410,873 14 Less estimated income 394 15 Total general fund appropriation \$410,479 16 SECTION 2. ALCOHOL AND DRUG EDUCATION PROGRAM - EXPENDITURE -

LIMITATIONS. The moneys appropriated in the grants line item in section 1 of this Act for the
Native American alcohol and drug abuse education program may not be spent for the services
provided by the tribes to administer the program. The local grant recipient is required to provide
match equal to the grant amount with funding or in-kind service.
