BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivision a of subsection 2 of section 39-01-01 of the 5 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 Class A authorized emergency vehicles means: a. 7 (1) Vehicles of a governmentally owned fire department. 8 Vehicles when operated by or under the control of a police officer (2) 9 having authority to enforce the provisions of this title or by a salaried 10 employee of any a municipal police department within the municipality 11 or by any a sheriff or deputy sheriff not to include including special 12 deputy sheriffs, or by the warden of the state penitentiary director of the 13 department of corrections and rehabilitation and his the director's authorized agents who have successfully completed training in the 14 15 operation of class A authorized emergency vehicles. 16 (3)Vehicles clearly identifiable as property of the department of corrections 17 and rehabilitation when operated or under the control of the director of 18 the department of corrections and rehabilitation. Ambulances. 19 (4) 20 (4) (5) Vehicles operated by or under the control of the director, and district 21 deputy director, and or a district deputy game warden of the North 22 Dakota game and fish department. 23 (5) <u>(6)</u> Vehicles owned or leased by the United States government and used 24 for law enforcement purposes.
