- The state department of health shall eause to be published <u>publish</u> in English, and in every other language that the department determines is the primary language of a significant number of state residents, within one hundred eighty days after July 1, 1991, the following easily comprehensible printed materials:
 - a. Geographically indexed materials designed to inform the woman of public and private agencies and services available to assist a woman through pregnancy, upon childbirth, and while the child is dependent, including adoption agencies. The materials must include a comprehensive list of the agencies available, a description of the services they the agencies offer and a description of the manner, including telephone numbers, in which they might the agencies may be contacted, or, at the option of the department, printed materials including a toll-free, twenty-four hour a day telephone number that may be called to obtain, orally, such a list and description of agencies in the locality of the caller and of the services they the agencies offer."
- Page 1, line 7, overstrike "unborn child" and insert immediately thereafter "<u>fetus</u>" and overstrike "two-week" and insert immediately thereafter "<u>four-week</u>"
- Page 1, line 9, overstrike "unborn child's"
- Page 1, line 10, after "survival" insert "of the fetus", remove "or drawings", and replace "unborn" with "a fetus"
- Page 1, line 11, remove "children", replace "two-week" with "four-week", and remove "or drawings"
- Page 1, line 15, overstrike "unborn child" and insert immediately thereafter "fetus"
- Page 1, after line 15, insert:
 - "2. The materials required under this section must be available at no cost from the state department of health upon request and in appropriate number to any person, facility, or hospital."
