- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 26.1-26 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to insurance agents acting as consultants; and to amend and reenact
- 3 section 26.1-26-35 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to insurance consultants and
- 4 consulting fees.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 26.1-26 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 8 Requirements of agents acting as consultants. A licensed insurance agent,
- 9 insurance broker, or surplus lines insurance broker, exempted from licensing as a consultant
- 10 under section 26.1-26-10, who receives a commission as a result of the sale of insurance to a
- 11 client, and who, by written agreement with the client, negotiates a fee for insurance consulting
- 12 services that is in addition to the commission, shall comply with the provisions and
- 13 requirements of a consultant's agreement as set forth in section 26.1-26-35. All commissions
- 14 and fees must comply with section 26.1-26-04.
- 15 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 26.1-26-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 16 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 17 **26.1-26-35. Duties of consultant Agreements.** An insurance consultant shall serve
- 18 with objectivity and complete loyalty the interests of the consultant's client alone and to render
- 19 the client such information, counsel, and service as within the knowledge, understanding, and
- 20 opinion, in good faith of the licensee, best serves the client's insurance needs and interests.
- 21 Before rendering any Any service set forth in subsection 4 of section 26.1-26-02, an insurance
- 22 consultant shall prepare for which a fee is charged, requires a written agreement on a form
- 23 approved by the commissioner. The agreement must outline the nature of the work to be
- 24 performed by the consultant and must state the fee for the work outlining the nature of the work

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- 1 to be performed by the consultant, and the fee structure agreed to by the consultant and client.
- 2 The consultant and the client shall sign the agreement. The consultant shall retain a copy of
- 3 the agreement for not less than two years after completion of the services. This In an
- 4 <u>insurance department inquiry, the</u> copy must be available to the commissioner.
