HB 1104: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision h of subsection 1 of section 57-38-01.2, subsection 5 of section 57-38-04, and subsection 2 of section 57-38-60 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to allocation and apportionment of nonresident income and employer income tax withholding return requirements; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the Finance and Taxation Committee.
