- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 44-04-18.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 44-04-18.5. Confidentiality of computer Computer software programs exempt. Any computer software program or component of a computer software program developed or acquired by a state agency, institution, department, or board and for which any the state agency, institution, department, or board acquires a license, copyright, or a patent is confidential exempt from section 44-04-18 and section 6 of article VI of the Constitution of North Dakota. After receiving written approval from the governor, a state agency, institution, department, or board may enter into agreements for the sale, licensing, and distribution of its contracted, licensed, patented, or copyrighted computer software programs; take any needed action, including legal action, to protect the state's interest in the computer software against improper or unlawful use or infringement; and collect and enforce the collection of any sums due for the licensing or sale of the computer software.
- **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure."
