- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 50-25.2-02 and 50-25.2-08 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to vulnerable adult protection services; and to repeal section
- 3 50-25.2-14 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the implementation of vulnerable adult
- 4 protection services.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 50-25.2-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **50-25.2-02.** Adult protective services program Rules. The department, with the
- 9 advice and cooperation of county social service boards, shall develop, administer, and cause to
- 10 be implemented a program of protective services for vulnerable adults consistent with this
- 11 chapter. In developing and administering the program, the department, within the limits of
- 12 legislative appropriation, shall allocate and distribute funds for the purpose of providing adult
- 13 protective services and shall provide the adult protective services in cooperation and
- 14 collaboration with other existing programs that serve adults in North Dakota. All law
- 15 enforcement agencies, courts of competent jurisdiction, and appropriate state and local
- 16 agencies shall cooperate in the implementation and enforcement of this chapter. The
- 17 department may adopt rules in accordance with chapter 28-32 for the purpose of implementing
- 18 the provisions of this chapter.
- 19 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 50-25.2-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 20 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 21 **50-25.2-08. Cost of adult protective services.** The vulnerable adult is responsible for
- 22 the costs of providing adult protective services, except the receipt, evaluation, and assessment
- 23 of reports of suspected abuse or neglect pursuant to subdivision a of subsection 3 of section
- 24 50-25.2-01, if the department or the department's designee determines, based on standards set

- 1 by the department, that the vulnerable adult is financially capable of paying for the protective
- 2 services received either through the vulnerable adult's own income or resources or other
- 3 programs for which the vulnerable adult may be eligible. The department or the department's
- 4 designee is not responsible for the cost of providing adult protective services unless the
- 5 provision of the services is specifically provided by law and funding exists to provide the
- 6 services.
- 7 **SECTION 3. REPEAL.** Section 50-25.2-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 8 repealed.
