- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for the establishment of a public utilities consumer advocacy
- 2 division to review certain public utility rates and to advocate on the behalf of residential and
- 3 small business public utilities consumers.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Public utilities consumer advocacy division.

- 1. The public utilities consumer advocacy division is a division of the public service commission. The division shall review public utility rates in this state and shall advocate on the behalf of residential and small business public utility consumers in this state. The commission shall obtain any assistance necessary to perform the functions of the division, including any expert help necessary to review public utility rates.
- For the purpose of funding the division, the commission shall assess a fee equal to
 one dollar per year for each service account of the utility to each electric, gas, and
 telecommunications utility company that is doing business in this state and is under
 any rulemaking or decisionmaking authority of the commission.
- 3. Subsection 2 does not apply to any public utility owned and operated by the state or any political subdivision of the state; any public utility that is not operated for profit; any nonprofit, cooperative, or mutual telecommunications company having fewer than eight thousand local exchange subscribers; any electric cooperative corporation, rural electric cooperative, or local electric cooperative; or any mutual aid cooperative or cooperative association.
